

**Note:** Traineeships are delivered by the Education and Training Boards (ETBs). The decision by an ETB to deliver a traineeship is determined based on the needs identified in collaboration with industry/employers in the sector and local requirements.

Therefore, not all ETBs will offer every traineeship; likewise, elements of a traineeship such as the content, award, duration etc may vary based on the needs identified.

**Barista and Bartending Skills Traineeship**

The aim of the programme is to provide trainees with the skills and related knowledge to work in the hospitality sector as a Barista and Bartender.

Employability Statement: This programme is suitable for learners who are seeking certification to enable them to source employment as a Barista and Bartender or for those already working at this level in the sector who are seeking to move into a supervisory position at a basic level.
