

Note: Traineeships are delivered by the Education and Training Boards (ETBs). The decision by an ETB to deliver a traineeship is determined based on the needs identified in collaboration with industry/employers in the sector and local requirements.

Therefore, not all ETBs will offer every traineeship; likewise, elements of a traineeship such as the content, award, duration etc may vary based on the needs identified.

The information below is a sample only; it gives an idea of what this traineeship involves but may not be replicated exactly across ETBs offering this traineeship.

SAMPLE DESCRIPTOR

Construction Skills for Employment Traineeship

This course is ideal for someone considering a career in Construction. It is a full time course comprised of a blend of direct instruction and work placement. It was designed in consultation with employers and aims to give participants the skills and knowledge they need to begin work in the Construction Industry. On successful completion of the course participants will achieve a City & Guilds Level 2 Certificate in Construction Operations, together with a range of industry recognised skills including Safepass, Manual Handling and the CSCS New Entrants Site Dumper ticket. Additionally, the course gives learners an introduction to and understanding of Formwork as a direct response to skills deficits in the industry. No previous experience is necessary. Participants should have an interest in gaining employment in the continually expanding Construction Industry.
